

## KTC THURSDAY CLUBNIGHT PLAYER GUIDANCE & FAQ'S

### 1. Can I Just Turn Up?

**NO** sorry You cannot just turn up!  
You will need to book your place.

### 2. How do I book a Club night slot?

**Reply to Tuesday eve invite on WhatsApp group.** Priority will be given to players who did not play on Tuesday and those who are not 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> team players.

### 3. How many members will be playing?

There will be a maximum of **20** subject to court availability. There will be one slot 18.30pm- 20.00pm. There may be one court changeover.

### 4. How will I know I have a Club Night slot?

Players will be confirmed on Wednesday eve.

### 5. Why are only **limited** Courts being used for Thursday Club Night?

Courts are required for matches and Club Coaches programme.

### 6. Are there special Covid-19 protocols in place for Club Nights? Yes there are ! In summary :

***o Please do not turn up if you are experiencing Coronavirus symptoms or have been in contact with anyone else who has or has tested positive or you been contacted by Track & Trace.***

*o Hand sanitising stations will be at the gate entrances. **Please bring your own too.***

*o KTC will provide the tennis balls - which will be pre-marked e.g.'3', '4' & '5' relating to which court the balls are to be used on. Do not touch the balls for another court.*

*o All allocated tennis balls should be left on court. They will be collected.*

*o **Up to 5** courts will be used from courts 3,4,5,6,7. Each court will have a specific queuing location to maintain social distancing whilst waiting to go on court. **This will be stated on that week's WhatsApp confirmation.***

### 7. Can I stay afterwards for a chat with other players and/or a drink?

*No, we're afraid not – all players will be asked to go straight home and **not** congregate outside the club house or in the carpark.*

*The Club House remains closed with only the toilets available in case of emergencies !*

Thursday clubnights will continue throughout the winter with floodlights free until December 31<sup>st</sup>.

A Saturday or Sunday Club afternoon is under consideration, subject to volunteer organisers being available.

## 10. What about non-member pay and play?

We have a large number of new and trial members and would like to increase activities for the expanded membership first.

We are required to be a COVID secure venue to remain open and this requires regular communication to members and it is difficult to brief people turning up ad hoc or for the first time and run the events as planned.

Anyone who knows someone who would like to try out the club could invite them along as their guest at a fee of £5 to be transferred to the Club bank account. There is also the 3 month offer for new members.
